Academic Watch Committee

This Committee is responsible for assisting with the tracking performance of students at LHHS. This includes: Attendance, Passing Rates, and Scores on PSAT, AP Test Scores and Benchmarks Tests. We would examine Tutorial Services Offered, Classes, and how students are performing (pass/fail rates) in those classes. The committee will examine how students perform on the GHSGT and End of Tests. We will follow how Level 1-3 students are performing and how sub groups performs. Some of the sub groups are Support Service Students, Minorities to the School, African American Males and students who fall below the poverty lines.

Advocacy/Legislative Committee/LSAC
